Mrs. Halvey, Former Writer, Buried

Phila., Mar. 21—Mrs. Brendan H. Halvey (born Shields), wife of Brendan H. Halvey, died March 10 at her home, 5323 N. 33rd St., following a heart attack. She was a graduate of Notre Dame Academy and was secretary of the American Catholic Historical Society and a frequent contributor to Catholic magazines and newspapers. She was editor of "Square," Notre Dame alumnae bulletin.

Mrs. Halvey wrote a syndicated column on the Roman Breviary for laymen which appeared in THE TABLET and other papers. She was known throughout the area as a lecturer and was identified with many Catholic organizations.

The funeral was held March 14. Solemn Requiem Mass was celebrated in the Church of the Holy Child by Rt. Rev. Msgr. Thomas F. McNally, LL.D., Rev. Anthony J. Flynn, S.T.L., Ph.D., was deacon, and Rev. John J. Murphy was sub-deacon.

Present in the sanctuary were Right. Rev. Msgr. John J. Bonner, D.D., LL.D., Rt. Rev. Msgr. Edward F. Hawks, Rt. Rev. Msgr. Bernard A. McKenna, S.T.D., LL.D., Very Rev. Thomas J. Love, S.J., and about twenty other priests.

Sisters of St. Joseph, Sisters of St. Francis, Sisters of Mercy, Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary and the Grey Nuns of the Sacred Heart also attended the Mass.

Interment was in Holy Cross Cemetery, where the blessing was given by Monsignor McKenna.

Besides her husband, Mrs. Halvey is also survived by a daughter, Patricia M., and two sons: Robert S. and Richard H. Halvey.
